

BHARC meeting minutes

- 1.0 The meeting was called to order by President Harry Martens WA0MFZ at 7:30pm at the School of Mines EE department lecture hall.
- 2.0 There was no treasurer's or secretary's report.
- 3.0 Scott will confirm the January meeting technical program with Steve Lawler, School of Mines on making circuit boards using the milling machines in the EE dept. Board designs can be produced using "free" circuit board programs.
- 4.0 It was reported that the club's ARES 706, power supply and LDG100 autotuner have disappeared. Rausch reported them missing on the Thursday prior to Skywarn Recognition Day. Lew or Chuck may have the serial number. It was suggested that the police, other local clubs, or QST be notified.

- 7.0 The technical presentation was given by Harry Martens WA0MFZ on a terrain analysis program used to predict VHF and UHF propagation from a specified lat / long/ elevation. Terrain, obstruction and output power data can be entered into the analysis.
